

Base Awards

One Base

- A pitch thrown out of play (7.05 h)
- Ball thrown out of play from the pitcher, while in contact with the rubber (7.05 h A.R.)
- Balk (8.05)
- Detached equipment on a pitched ball – time ball was touched (7.05 j)
- Fielder falls after carrying a ball out of play (7.04 c)
FED: Fielder carries the ball out of play (8-3, 2-9-1)

Two Bases

Time of pitch

- Ball thrown out of play on the first play by an infielder (7.05 g)
- Ground rule double, including a fair ball deflected over a fence in foul territory (7.05 f)

Time of throw

- Ball thrown out of play by an outfielder (7.05 g)
- Ball thrown out of play by infielder, but is not the first play (7.05 g)
- Ball thrown out of play by an infielder, when all runners including the batter-runner have advanced one base (7.05 g A.R.)
- Detached equipment on a thrown ball (7.05 d, e)

Three Bases

- Detached equipment on a batted ball, time of pitch (7.05 b, c)

Four Bases

- Home run (7.05 a)
- Fair ball deflected over the fence in fair territory (7.05 a)
- Detached equipment on a batted ball with possibility of being a home run (7.05 a)

*Always award the lead runner first
